## **GOVERNMENT OPERATIONS**

Council District 14 is in need of additional office space downtown for constituent services. The former Mexican Consulate space in the Biscailuz building at the El Pueblo Historical Monument is vacant, and would be an optimal location for a constituent services office to serve the area, as it is adjacent to Union Station and easy for constituents to access. As this property is under the control of the El Pueblo de Los Angeles Historical Monument Authority Commission, and the Commission's approval is required for this use.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the El Pueblo de Los Angeles Historical Monument Authority Commission be requested to authorize the use of the former Mexican Consulate space in the Biscailuz Building by Council District 14 for a constituent services center to serve the downtown area.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Department of General Services be directed to negotiate and execute any license agreement, memorandum of understanding, or other necessary agreement on behalf of Council District 14 for the use of this facility, upon approval of this use by the Commission.
