TRADE, TRAVEL AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the redevelopment of the former Lincoln Heights Jail located at 401 North Avenue 19, Los Angeles, California 90031.

Recommendations for Council action, initiated by Motion (Hernandez – McOsker):

- 1. INSTRUCT the Economic and Workforce Development Department (EWDD), with support from the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA), City Administrative Officer (CAO), General Services Department (GSD), Bureau of Engineering (BoE), Los Angeles Department of Sanitation (LASAN), and City Attorney to report back within 120 Days providing a high level order of operations for the site to move forward and assessing possibilities of future use of the site, including necessary departmental funding and external funding sources required to move forward with plans. This includes LASAN reporting on continued remediation of the site and coordination with the LA Regional Water Quality Control Board.
- 2. INSTRUCT EWDD with support from Council District 1, to develop a community engagement plan within 150 days, including recommendations for outside support necessary to move a community engagement plan forward.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the CLA has completed a financial analysis of this report.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on October 3, 2023, the Trade, Travel, and Tourism Committee considered Motion (Hernandez – McOsker) relative to the redevelopment of the former Lincoln Heights Jail located at 401 North Avenue 19, Los Angeles, California 90031.

After an opportunity for public comment was held, the Committee moved to approve the Motion, as amended, to include external funding sources in recommendation no. 1 and removing recommendation no. 3 entirely, as detailed above. This matter is now forwarded to the Council for its consideration.
