Art has always been a passion of mine and the Arts District is a neighborhood I call home. The Rendon Hotel project is made by and for artists and will have a tremendous impact on the artistic community in Los Angeles.

Ralph and Maria Ziman are artists and members of our community with a strong track record of organizing opportunities that celebrate past artists, showcase current artists like myself and educate future artists.
