Over recent days, protests decrying police brutality in response to the brutal murder of George Floyd by a Minneapolis Police officer have resulted in clashes between police and protesters across the country, including in Los Angeles. While the majority of protests have been peaceful, there have also been significant incidents of vandalism, arson and looting. On May 30th, a State of Emergency was declared in the City, the Army National Guard was deployed, and a curfew was imposed. The City has not faced this level of unrest since 1992.

While it is too early to draw conclusions on use of force, it is imperative that the LAPD report with an after action review of the resulting incidents and the Department's response once calm returns.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Chief of Police report with an after-action report of the events leading up to and the Police Department's actions during the period of civil unrest that began on May 29, 2020 in response to the killing of George Floyd.
