Summary: The Silver Lake Neighborhood Council's Government Affairs Committee and Urban Design and Preservation Committee do not support the Restaurant Beverage Program CPC-2018-4660-CA as written. The proposed program fails to pay sufficient respect to neighboring residential or commercial uses. We believe the proposed program must include advance notification to neighbors within 500 feet and to neighborhood councils, require a public hearing, and an appeals process. The draft program proposal allows no opportunity for public input before a clearance is granted. The program would eliminate the opportunity for site-specific, operation-specific or neighborhood-specific comment. Stakeholders in neighborhoods know their communities the best, and their input results in better projects including those requiring Restaurant Beverage permits.
