Winter Shelter Program Extension

As part of the City's general homeless shelter system, the Winter Shelter Program (WSP) is a seasonal operation meant to provide short-term and immediate accommodations to protect the homeless population from inclement weather. The WSP has customarily operated from December 1st thru March 1st of any given year.

Due to unusually severe conditions over the past few winters, Council has taken action to extend WSP operation an additional 30 days (through March 31st) including providing the additional funding needed to cover expenditures. Concurrently, the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors has taken corresponding action. Most recently, on Tuesday, November 21, 2017 the Board of Supervisors approved a motion extending the County's 2017-2018 Winter Shelter Program through March 31, 2018.

During 2016-2017, the funding needed to pay for the additional 30 days of the City's program came from LAHSA savings. LAHSA intends to extend the City's WSP through March 31, 2018 using unspent FY 17-18 programmatic savings. LAHSA anticipates these savings will not cover the full amount of the 30 day extension and, therefore, will return to this committee to request any additional funding as needed.
