MOTION

On March 5, 2002, under Council File No. 01-1459, the City Council adopted new procedures for processing street vacations, which require the adoption of a Rule 16 motion to initiate street vacation proceedings. Under these new procedures, when a petitioner submits an application and a fee deposit to the Bureau of Engineering, the Chair of the Public Works Committee is required to introduce a motion for the purpose of initiating the investigation of the vacation.

The City Council on October 18, 2006, under Council File No. 06-2468, conditionally approved the vacation of Via Las Vegas Vacation District. The vacation conditions were not complied with prior to the expiration of the vacation approval.

The Los Angeles Unified School District, owner of the property legally described as Lots 5 through 10, of the Subdivision of H.J. Woolacott's First Street Tract, and Lot 1, Arbs 1 through 3, of the Salt Lake Station Tract, and Lots 8 through 11, Block A, and Lots 27 through 32, Block B, of the Clement Tract; has submitted a new application requesting to vacate the same streets, located in Council District 14.

Additionally, the adoption of the following recommendations does not constitute or imply approval of the vacation.

I THEREFORE MOVE that upon adoption of this motion, street vacation proceedings be initiated pursuant to California Streets and Highways Code, Division 9, Part 3, Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering be directed to process this vacation request under Council File No. 06-2468, and Engineering work order No. E1401012, and apply the conditions established under the Council action of October 1, 2008, under Council File No. 06-2468 to this vacation request.

I FURTHER REQUEST that the City Clerk append this Motion to Council File No. 06-2468.

I FURTHER MOVE that the Bureau of Engineering present its report regarding the feasibility of vacating the requested area to the Public Works Committee.
