The City of Los Angeles offers a reward payable at the discretion of the City Council to one or more persons in the sum or sums up to an aggregate maximum total sum of \$50,000 for information leading to the identification and apprehension of the person or persons responsible for the DEATH OF DAVON PLEDGER, in the city of Los Angeles. On May 9, 2020, at approximately 10:40 p.m., 26-year old Davon Pledger was standing outside a friend's house on Cornelius Street in Pacoima, when three Hispanic males approached him in a dark-colored Honda Civic. These unknown individuals then opened fire on Mr. Pledger, striking him 16 times and fatally wounding him. Detectives are continuing to investigate this crime but have not been able to identify any leads. The detectives believe a reward may compel member of the public to provide information on the persons responsible for this crime. The person or persons responsible for this crime represent an ongoing threat to the safety of the people of Los Angeles; therefore, it is appropriate for the City of Los Angeles to offer a reward for information leading to the identification, apprehension, and conviction of the person or persons responsible for this crime. Unless withdrawn or paid by City Council action, this offer of reward shall terminate on, and have no effect after, JANUARY 20, 2021.

The provisions of payment and all other considerations shall be governed by Chapter 12 of Division 19 of the LAMC Code, as amended by Ordinance Nos. 181457 and 180666. This offer shall be given upon the condition that all claimants provide continued cooperation within the criminal justice system relative to this case and is not available to public officers or employees of the City, their families, persons in law enforcement or persons whose conduct prompted this reward.
