Comments for Public Posting: Carolina Goodman, speaking for the League of Women Voters of Los Angeles: Re: 2020 Redistricting Process There must be a complete ban on Ex Parte communications, as the State of California has. This includes all communication regarding redistricting between Commissioners or Commission Staff and groups or individuals. Regarding notice requirements for meetings: Require 14 days notice, as the State Commission did. (See Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act) People need more than the 3-day Brown Act requirement in order to be able to arrange their schedules to speak to the Commission. Regarding the drawing of district lines: Require two commissioners who are not residents of the same district to work with line drawers to create draft maps; the draft maps are presented to the public with the rationale used in drawing the drafts; public then comments.
