FY 2018 – 21 Prop. 56 CA Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tobacco

Tax Act of 2016 Grant Award

Transmitted herewith for Mayor and City Council consideration is a continuation grant award totaling \$1,650,593 for FY 2018-21 to address illegal sales of tobacco products to minors.

Funding originates from the Prop. 56 California Healthcare, Research and Prevention Tobacco Tax Act of 2016, which is administered by the California Attorney General's Office through a competitive grant process. Council previously accepted a FY 2017-20 award (CF #12-1204-S6) to launch LA DATA (Decreasing Adolescent Tobacco Access), which is a comprehensive citywide youth tobacco cessation program.

Through the new \$1,650,593 grant award, the City Attorney's Office will enhance DATA through the following: 1) maintaining retailer compliance checks; 2) increasing outreach and enforcement activities at tobacco only stores; and 3) developing new regulations around flavored tobacco products.

Specifically, City Attorney's Office will continue to contract with the California Department of Public Health Food and Drug Branch (CDPH) to conduct compliance checks utilizing undercover minor decoys throughout the City. In addition, funding will support personnel costs to conduct outreach to tobacco only stores regarding illegal sales to minors and the development of policies to regulate flavored tobacco products that have surged in popularity among youth.

LA DATA CONTROLLER INSTRUCTIONS

As part of the acceptance process, we request that the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor:

- 1. **AUTHORIZE** the City Attorney or his designee to approve the Standard Agreement with the State of California Department of Justice for the period of July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2020, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
- 2. **ACCEPT** funding in the amount of \$1,650,593 from the State of California Department of Justice for the period July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2020.
- 3. **ADOPT** the attached Resolution requested by the California Attorney General's Office for receipt of the grant award.
- 4. **AUTHORIZE** the Controller to:
 - a. Establish a receivable within Fund 368 in the amount of \$1,650,593 from the State of California Department of Justice
 - b. Establish a new appropriation account within Fund 368 as follows:

Account 12R643 – LA DATA Program (2018-21) - \$1,650,593

- c. Transfer \$32,489 from Fund 368, Account 12R642 LA DATA Program to Fund 100, Department 12, Account 001010 Salaries General.
- d. Upon approval of expenses and receipt of grant funds, transfer up to \$45,736 from Fund 368, Account 12R643 to Fund 100, Department 12, Revenue Source 5361 Reimbursement related costs, Other as reimbursement for fringe benefits and indirect costs related to the LA DATA project for the period July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2020.
- 5. **AUTHORIZE** the City Council to Instruct the City Clerk to place on Council Calendar for July 1, 2019, the following action relative to the LA DATA PROGRAM:

That the City Council, subject to the approval of the Mayor, **AUTHORIZE** the Controller to:

- a. Transfer \$33,051 from Fund 368, Department 12, Account 12R643 LA DATA program (2018-21) to Fund 100, Department 12, Account 001010 Salaries General.

LOS ANGELES CITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION

Proposition 56 Grant

WHEREAS the Los Angeles City Attorney's Office desires to participate in the Proposition 56 grant program administered by the California Attorney General's Office to establish LA DATA ("Decreasing Adolescent Tobacco Access). In partnership with the Los Angeles Police Department, LA DATA will feature aggressive tobacco retailer enforcement, hookah lounge enforcement/abatement, and widespread youth outreach as coordinated through a new anti-tobacco task force. LA DATA will also feature an intensive, multi-media outreach campaign to address youth centered tobacco use entitled "Join the Conversation."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the *City Attorney, Michael N. Feuer*, be authorized on behalf of the *City of Los Angeles* to enter in the FY 2018 - 2021 Grant Agreement with the California Attorney General's Office, including any amendments thereof.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the **Los Angeles City Attorney's Office** agrees to abide by the terms and conditions of the Grant Agreement as set forth by the California Attorney General's Office.
