

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the application and acceptance of a grant award for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2018 Strategies for Policing Innovation Program.

Recommendations for Council action, SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:

1. AUTHORIZE the Chief, Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD), or designee, to:
 - a. Retroactively apply for and accept the grant award from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance for the FY 2018 Strategies for Policing Innovation Program grant in the amount of \$700,000 for the period of October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2022.
 - b. Negotiate and execute a Professional Services Agreement with Justice & Security Strategies, Inc., a sub-recipient agency, for the provision of grant research partner services, for a term within the applicable grant performance period, for a sum not to exceed \$225,000, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
 - c. Negotiate and execute a Professional Services Agreement with the University of California, Los Angeles, a sub-recipient agency, for the provision of grant research partner services, for a term within the applicable grant performance period, for a sum not to exceed \$150,000, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
 - d. Negotiate and execute the grant award agreement, subject to the approval of the City Attorney as to form.
2. AUTHORIZE the LAPD to:
 - a. Spend up to the total grant amount of \$700,000 in accordance with the grant award agreement.
 - b. Submit grant reimbursement requests to the grantor and deposit the grant receipts in the Police Department Grants Fund No. 339/70.
 - c. Prepare Controller instructions for any technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), and authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.
3. Authorize the Controller to:
 - a. Establish a grant receivable and appropriate \$700,000 to an appropriation account to be determined, in Fund No. 339/70, for the receipt and disbursement of the 2018 Strategies for Policing Innovation Program.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The CAO reports that approval of the above recommendations will provide up to \$700,000 in funding to the LAPD for the 2018 Strategies for Policing Innovation Program grant. No matching funds are required and there is no impact to the General Fund as a result of these recommendations. Acceptance of the grant and the approval of the recommendations in this report are in compliance with the City's Financial Policies, whereas one-time grant funding will be utilized for one-time program expenditures.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

SUMMARY

At its regular meeting held on February 27, 2019, the Public Safety Committee considered Board of Police Commissioners and CAO reports relative to the application and acceptance of a grant award for the FY 2018 Strategies for Policing Innovation Program.
